Regulations of the “AGH SCIENCE meetings”, hereinafter referred to as the “Regulations”

§ 1 General provisions

1. The objective of the project “AGH SCIENCE meetings,” hereinafter referred to as the “**Project**,” is the activity aimed at shaping a society based on science by popularising science and showing its practical applications.
2. The Project disseminates science in the form of public lectures and interviews (hereinafter referred to as the “**meetings**”), the recordings of which may be also uploaded online by means of dedicated and publicly available platforms.
3. The Organiser of the Project is the AGH University of Krakow:

hereinafter referred to as the “**Organiser**.”
4. The unit responsible for the implementation of the Project is the AGH University Centre for Communication and Marketing, Editorial and science popularisation section, hereinafter referred to as the “**Centre**” (address: al. Mickiewicza 30, 30-059 Kraków, building A-0, room 112).
5. In substantive matters, the Centre is supported by the Programme Board, hereinafter referred to as the “**Board**.” The composition of the Board is available online at www.spotkania.agh.edu.pl/rada-programowa.

§ 2 Programme Board

1. The Board consists of 3 research and didactic employees of the AGH University and the Director of the Centre.
2. The members of the Board are appointed by the AGH University Rector.
3. The responsibilities of the Board include advising and supporting the Centre in substantive matters related to the Project but predominantly in:
 - a. selecting the subject matter of the meetings,
 - b. selecting the speakers,
 - c. conducting the meetings.
4. Within the scope of its responsibilities, the Board closely cooperates with the Centre’s employees delegated by the Director of the Centre responsible for the implementation of the project.
5. The Board is appointed by the AGH University Rector for a term lasting one academic year.
6. The members of the Board can be revoked by the AGH University Rector prior to the end of term.

§ 3 Participation in the meetings

1. The events in the series “AGH SCIENCE meetings” are open to the public and the participation is free of charge.
2. Dates and places of the meetings along with planned topics shall be published by the Organiser on the website www.spotkania.agh.edu.pl/terminy.
3. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel planned meetings at any given moment without giving a reason. Relevant information shall be published on the website www.spotkania.agh.edu.pl.
4. Participants of the meeting are obliged to comply with the provisions of the Regulations and to behave in a manner that does not endanger the safety of other participants, in particular to:
 - a. comply with OHS and fire protection regulations,
 - b. comply with the instructions of the Organiser and security services.
5. The Organiser reserves the right to remove from the meeting participants behaving in a manner that:
 - a. endanger the safety of other participants,
 - b. disrupts the order and violates generally accepted norms of behaviour in public places,
 - c. violates the rules of personal culture and interferes with other participants' reception of the meetings.
6. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse participation in the meeting to people who are under the influence of intoxicants.

§ 4 Recordings of the meetings

1. The Organiser reserves the right to take photos and videos during the meetings which may be later used for promotional purposes in printed and electronic publications as well as on social media profiles of the Organiser.
2. Pursuant to Art. 81 of 4 February 1994 of the Law of Copyright and Related Rights (i.e. Journal of Laws 2021 item 1062), permission is not required for the distribution of the image of:
 - a. a well-known person, if the image was taken due to the performance of the public functions, particularly political, social, professional, of the person;
 - b. a person being merely a detail of a whole such as a gathering, a landscape, a public event.

§ 5 Final provisions

2. The Organiser reserves the right to amend the Regulations, which shall be announced each time on the website www.spotkania.agh.edu.pl.
